**Re:** Electronic Eligibility Verification System (EEVS) Vendors

OMAP offers several ways for you to verify client eligibility before you render services: the Medical Care ID that the client carries, the Automated Information System (AIS) that is accessed via either phone or the Internet, or the Electronic Eligibility Verification System (EEVS). The first two services remain in effect, and we are updating EEVS information here.

The EEVS method requires you to work with a vendor to set up service in a way that is most convenient for you (e.g., modem or magnetic striped cards). EEVS verifications are available to you in "real time" 24 hours a day, seven days a week. EEVS vendors also contract with private insurance carriers, allowing users to access other insurance company databases.

EEVS provides the following information:

- Client eligibility
- Prepaid health plan enrollment
- Third party resources
- Health care coverage limitations or restrictions
- Value-added services from individual vendors.

If you are interested in EEVS services, please contact the suppliers directly about their products and associated costs. A list of current EEVS vendors appears on the second page of this notice.
