Effective: October 1, 2004

The Health Services Commission (HSC) has concluded its review of the Prioritized List of Health Services for changes effective October 1, 2004. The condition and treatment pairs are currently funded through Line 546.

The majority of changes are related to the deletion and addition of old and new ICD-9-CM and CPT codes to the appropriate pairing lines. Several lines have been modified to reflect changes and limitations associated with new guidelines and clinical review in the areas of imaging, organ transplant, cardiac, physical, occupational and speech therapies.
