Change in Maximum Allowable Amount for Non-Sterile Gloves (A4927)

Effective March 1, 2006, OMAP will reduce the maximum allowable amount for non-sterile gloves to \$10 per box of 100 gloves. OMAP has made this reduction for the following reasons:

- Market research indicates that non-sterile gloves can be purchased for significantly less than OMAP's previous allowable of \$15.
- The Department of Human Services' 2005-2007 Legislatively Adopted Budget requires OMAP to reduce fee-for-service spending.
