The Department is preparing to do a mass payment adjustment for Home Health services providers to automatically correct some minor underpayments and overpayments. As a result, some Home Health providers will see a small net increase or decrease on your next remittance advice. Providers need not submit any paperwork.

Fee schedule changes (some fees increased; others decreased) that became effective 10/01/03 were not programmed into the MMIS until mid-April 2006. No one provider should have a significant over/underpayment as a result of the adjustment.
