## Revision of MMIS Implementation Schedule

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Last month, you received Issue 1 of the *MMIS Insider*, which announced that DHS would implement the replacement Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS) in the summer of 2007.

With the goal of attaining the highest quality system for our providers and partners, DHS has decided to delay implementation of the new MMIS three to six months past that timeframe.

- This schedule change allows more time for DHS to complete several critical development and testing activities. We will notify you when we have confirmed a new date for implementation of the replacement MMIS.
- This change will **not** affect the dates for required compliance with the National Provider Identifier (NPI) rule. DHS will still require NPI for all affected provider types and claims beginning May 23, 2007.

We remain confident of the project's overall success and believe the schedule change will be an investment in the overall quality and functionality of the system.
