Subject: RVU code changes

On January 1, 2007, DMAP will update the Relative Value Unit (RVU) weight assignment for CPT and HCPCS codes, using the 2006 non-facility RVU weight published in the *Federal Register Vol. 70*, dated November 21, 2005.

The base rates for services will remain unchanged:

- The base rate for anesthesia service will continue to be \$23.35.
- The base rate for delivery services (59400-59622) will continue to be \$38.80.
- CPT codes 92340-92342 and 92352-92353 will continue to be paid at a flat rate of \$25.00.
- The base rate for all other CPT and HCPCS codes with an RVU weight assignment will continue to be \$25.95.
