Subject: Billing for physician-administered drugs

Last July, DMAP began requiring national drug codes (NDCs) on electronic claims because of the federal Deficit Reduction Act requirements for state Medicaid programs.

You are receiving this letter to correct a common omission in the billing of physician-administered drugs. You are currently billing DMAP for these drugs without the NDC on the claim. The Department cannot obtain associated federal rebates unless we have these codes. From now on, please help us to be fiscally responsible by including the NDC when billing DMAP for physician-administered drugs.

The new DHS Medicaid Management Information System, scheduled to go online late in 2007, will automatically deny drug claims that don't include the NDC. This makes it especially important to begin billing correctly now.
