Subject: Electronic Medicaid claims submissions

In September Oregon's Department of Human Services is implementing a replacement Medicaid Management Information System. MMIS is the system that pays Medicaid claims and tracks all our provider and client information.

Claims submission formats

You currently may be submitting your claims to DHS Seniors and People with Disabilities on a Turn Around Document (TAD). Once the MMIS replacement goes into effect, the department will **no longer accept TADs**. Instead DHS will accept your claims in one of several ways:

1. Paper UB-04 billing form
2. Internet site (a.k.a., Web portal) in UB-04 or roster billing format
3. Electronic 837 Institutional (similar to what you may send Medicare now)
4. Crossover claims from Medicare

MMIS provider billing training sessions

You can learn how to use the first two methods at provider trainings scheduled around the state beginning this month. If you have not already registered, please choose one convenient to you at www.oregon.gov/DHS/mmis/training-info.shtml.

Electronic Data Interchange (EDI)

If you choose Option 3, to directly submit claims electronically via the 837 Institutional format, contact DHS EDI Support at 888-690-9888 or DHS.EDIsupport@state.or.us. The team will send you all the information you need to get started.
