DMAP will be ending its contracts with the Electronic Eligibility Verification Services (EEVS) vendors at the end of the current contract period, August 31, 2008. EEVS is one of the ways DHS providers have been able to verify Medicaid client eligibility.

Beginning September 1, 2008, providers can verify eligibility in the new MMIS system in the following ways:

- Automated Voice Response (AVR)
- Electronic Data Interchange 270/271 transaction
