The Yakima Valley Farm Workers Clinics will no longer accept CareOregon. DHS offices in Clackamas, Marion, Multnomah, Umatilla and Washington counties may receive requests for changes in enrollment. If CareOregon clients request a change in enrollment to stay with the Yakima Valley Farm Workers Clinics, verify that:

- 1. Fully capitated health plan (FCHP) enrollment changes are made at appropriate times:**
 - a. At recertification
 - b. If they have been enrolled with the plan for at least 6 months
 - c. Under special conditions
- 2. The client lives in the requested plan's service area on KSEL.** FamilyCare FCHP and Marion Polk Community Health Plan (MPCHP) are currently contracted with Yakima Valley Farm Workers Clinic. FamilyCare does NOT provide mental health services in Marion County. Mid-Valley Behavioral Care Network provides mental health services in Marion County.
- 3. The client's primary care provider (PCP) and any specialist are contracted with the requested plan.**

4. **The client selected FamilyCare as their FCHP in Multnomah, Washington or Clackamas counties. MMIS will auto enroll the client in FamilyCare Mental Health Organization.** Those members in Multnomah County, that were enrolled with CareOregon for medical services and with Verity for mental health services that have questions or concerns about continuity of care, can contact 503-988-5464.
5. **Medicare clients have both Medicare Part A and B Coverage (dual eligible).** Use the DMAP 7208M (Medicare Advantage Plan Election) form to assign their Medicare benefits to the requested plan. Medicare clients with Part B coverage only cannot be enrolled into a Medicare Advantage Plan.

CareOregon clients who currently receive services at the Yakima Valley Farm Workers Clinics will get a letter from CareOregon informing them of their new PCP. If CareOregon clients wish to continue with CareOregon and have questions or concerns about continuity of care, contact CareOregon Member Services at 1-800-224-4840.
