Message: DMAP will mail the attached postcard to all providers indicating that the following programs have Rulebook updates due to Temporary rule filings, effective April 1, 2009: OHP, Pharmaceutical Services, and Medical Transportation Services. In OHP, the Oregon Health Services Commission's Prioritized List of Health Services is revised with the April 1, 2009 modifications. In the Pharmaceutical Services program, rule 410-121-0155 is revised to reflect new reimbursement rates for drugs provided by the DMAP contracted mail order pharmacy provider. In the Medical Transportation Services program, revisions clarify text that had the potential to prohibit certain appropriate transports of eligible OHP Plus clients to Oregon Health Plan-covered medical services.
