### **Temporary rule made permanent - Effective April 1, 2010**

#### **■ General Rules:**

- 410-120-1295 - The Division of Medical Assistance Programs (DMAP) permanently amended the temporary 410-120-1295 to reference the reimbursement methodology changes indicated in HB 3259 (2009 Legislative session), effective for services rendered on or after October 1, 2009

*Note: When rule text is unchanged from temporary to permanent status, DMAP places the effective date at the bottom of the rule and informs providers of the change in status.*

### **New Temporary rules - Effective April 1, 2010**

#### **■ Medical Transportation Services Program**

- 40-136-0245 - DMAP temporarily amended to clarify that an additional adult attendant is not required for non-emergent medical transportation provider by a DHS employee or DHS volunteer or for secured transports provided under OAR 410-136-0240. This is necessary to ensure child clients maintain access to appropriate transportation services.-

#### **■ OHP (Managed Care) Program:**

- 410-141-0520 - DMAP temporarily amended 410-141-0520, referencing the January 1, 2010 – December 31, 2011 Health Services Commission's Prioritized List with interim modifications and technical changes effective April 1, 2010, this included application of 2009 national code to the HSC lines and HSC guideline refinements.

#### **■ Pharmaceutical Services Program:**

- 410-121-0146 - Clarifies the current DMAP policy for 34-day and 100-day supply of drugs dispensed and exceptions to both.
