Temporary rule made permanent - Effective April 26, 2010

Oregon Health Plan (OHP Managed Care):

410-141-0520 - DMAP permanently amended the temporary rule 410-141-0520, referencing the January 1, 2010 – December 31, 2011 Health Services Commission's Prioritized List with interim modifications and technical changes effective April 1, 2010, this included application of 2009 national code to the HSC lines and HSC guideline refinements.

New Temporary rule - Effective May 1, 2010

Federally Qualified Health Centers/Rural Health Clinics

410-147-0365 - DMAP temporarily amended to clarify that an additional adult attendant is not required for non-emergent medical transportation provider by a DHS employee or DHS volunteer or for secured transports provided under OAR 410-136-0240. This is necessary to ensure child clients maintain access to appropriate transportation services.
