Message: DMAP will mail a letter directly to providers who are required to have a National Provider Identifier (NPI) but do not have one on file with us asking them to fax their NPI to us. If they do not have an NPI, we asked that they apply for one (link to application included) and then fax the information to us.

Those providers who are not subject to NPI requirements are not included.

Providers who are subject to NPI requirements need to know that the recent passage of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (Act), HR 3590, requires Department of Human Services to begin denying their claims submitted on or after January 1, 2011 if they do not include NPI.

A similar announcement will be posted for all providers subject to the NPI requirements, informing them of the Jan. 1, deadline. The announcement will be posted at:

To comply with the recently passed Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (Act), the Division of Medical Assistance Programs will begin denying claims that do not include a National provider Identifier (NPI) on January 1, 2011 for providers that are subject to the NPI requirements.

Providers that are not subject to NPI requirements are not included.

If you are subject to the NPI requirements, please make sure your claims continue to be accepted and processed by including your NPI with each claim submitted.
