Subject: Medicaid Financial Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP) match changes for Jan. 1, through June 30, 2011.

The Medicaid FMAP increases allowed in the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) have changed for Jan. 1 through June 30, 2011. During this period, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services decreased FMAP, which results in an increase in the local match rate. Public Law 111-226 provides a two-quarter phased-down extension of the increases.

The following table reflects the changes. Please use this table as you continue to submit claims with your local match payment.

| Dates → | 1/1/11 through 3/31/11 | 4/1/11 through 6/30/11 (*preliminary; subject to change) |
|--------------------|-------------------------------|---|
| ARRA FMAP | 70.14% | *68.25% |
| Local Match | 29.86% | *31.75% |
