Adjustments for HFA inhaler overpayments now scheduled for July 23 weekend

The weekend of July 23, the Division of Medical Assistance Programs (DMAP) plans to reprocess all pharmacy claims from January 1, 2011, to April 20, 2011, where DMAP paid more than the allowed amount for the following products:

- Ventolin HFA
- ProAir HFA
- Proventil HFA

Payment and remittance advice information

DMAP will collect the overpayments from payments that process the weekend of July 23.

- When this happens, your paper RA will list Explanation of Benefit (EOB) message 8167 - DHS initiated adjustment due to processing error.
- The Financial Transactions page of future paper RAs will track any remaining balance.
- If you currently receive the 835 (Electronic Remittance Advice), your 835 for the weekend of July 23 should report the adjustment(s) as overpayment recoveries.
