Message:

Effective January 1, 2012, Greater Oregon Behavioral Health, Inc. (GOBHI) will become the mental health organization providing OHP mental health managed care services to members in Hood River (M021), Wasco (M022) and Sherman (M023) counties.

Effective January 1, 2012, Clackamas Mental Health Organization (CMHO) will no longer provide managed care mental health services in Hood River (M059), Wasco (M062) and Sherman (M061) counties under the Oregon Health Plan (OHP).

Mid-Columbia Centers for living has been the service provider through CMHO in these areas. They will continue to do so, now under a subcontract with GOBHI. No interruption of services is expected for existing OHP members.
