Apply for 2011 Medicaid EHR program incentives by Feb. 29, 2012

Eligible professionals must submit their application for 2011 Medicaid Electronic Health Record (EHR) Program incentives via the Provider Web Portal at <https://www.or-medicaid.gov> no later than Wednesday, Feb. 29, 2012. Are you ready to apply?

Application checklist

- Confirm that you are correctly enrolled as a DMAP provider with access as an individual provider to the Provider Web Portal by Jan. 27, 2012;
- Collect patient volume data from a representative 90-day period in 2010 that shows you meet Medicaid EHR Incentive Program criteria;
- Obtain documentation that you have adopted, implemented, or upgraded to certified EHR technology; and
- Register with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services for the EHR Incentive Program.
