# Fee-for-service providers

**4010 submitters - Please complete 5010 registration by Mar. 1, 2012**

DMAP will end 4010 mailbox access for trading partners who have not completed the following steps by Mar. 1. **All trading partners must complete these steps in order to proceed to 5010 business-to-business testing:**

- **Submit a completed DMAP 2084** ([Oregon Medicaid 4010 Request Form](#)) that lists all transactions you need to exchange in 4010 format;
- **Submit a completed DMAP 2083** ([Exhibit C - EDI Registration Change Form](#)) to register for the 5010 versions of the transactions you currently exchange with DMAP; and
- **Begin third-party testing on DMAP's invitation-only Web site.** The Technical Contact listed in Section 6 of your completed DMAP 2083 will receive the invitation to this site. Please make sure the e-mail address listed is for an individual, not a group.

**If you have submitted 5010 registration but have not received an invitation to third-party testing, please contact EDI Support Services as soon as possible.**

- Missing or incorrect information on your completed DMAP 2083 will delay processing.
- Changes from how you currently exchange 4010 information with us, such as new transactions, a new billing service, or a new authorized signer, require completing additional forms.
