Rebill physician-administered drug claims that report family planning NDCs

The Division of Medical Assistance Programs (DMAP) received reports that physician-administered drug claims for procedure codes S4993 and J7304 denied with Explanation of Benefit (EOB) message *0403 - National Drug Code (NDC) not on drug file; correct and resubmit*. In many cases, the denied NDCs were for products available only to 340B providers, such as products in a “clinic package.”

Effective June 18, 2012, claims that report these NDCs will no longer deny for EOB 0403.

Rebill S4993 and J7304 claims to DMAP

Please rebill family planning NDCs that denied for EOB 0403 (see list at right).

The list at right may not be an exhaustive list, as we relied on provider reports of denials to create this list.

Reminder about billing 340B drugs

To bill DMAP for 340B drugs, eligible organizations must:

- Enroll with DMAP with provider specialty 408, using the National Provider Identifier (NPI) used for 340B purchasing. This NPI should be on the federal Health Resources and Services Administration’s Medicaid Exclusion file.
- Bill DMAP using the NPI enrolled under specialty 408.

Reimbursement is the lesser of the acquisition cost, the Federal Upper Limit, or federal 340B pricing.
