Effective 7/18/12, FamilyCare FCHP (H192, H057, H193 and H234) will close to new enrollment in Clackamas, Multnomah, Washington and Marion counties.

FamilyCare MHO (M053) will remain open in Clackamas, Multnomah, Washington and Marion counties. Enrollment in this MHO is limited to clients not enrolled in a Coordinated Care Organization (CCO).

Effective 8/1/12, FamilyCare CCO will open to new enrollment in Clackamas (E005), Multnomah (E015), Washington (E020) and Marion (E010) counties. Starting Aug. 1, newly eligible OHP clients in these counties will be enrolled in the CCO for both physical and mental health care.
