

HHS Press Release: HHS Secretary Kathleen Sebelius Announces Compliance Date for ICD-10

Health and Human Services [Secretary Kathleen Sebelius announced](#) the release of a [rule](#) that makes final a one-year proposed delay—from October 1, 2013, to October 1, 2014—in the compliance date for the industry's transition to ICD-10 codes. Secretary Sebelius first announced the proposed delay in April, as part of President Obama's commitment to reducing regulatory burden.

The deadline for the transition to ICD-10 is October 1, 2014.
