Subject: **New rate for Babies First/CaCoon TCM services effective September 2, 2012**

The Division of Medical Assistance Programs (DMAP) has a new calculated fee-for-service rate for Babies First!/CaCoon TCM program services provided to Oregon Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) clients.

- Starting today, you can bill DMAP at the new rate for claims with dates of service on or after Sept. 2.
- New rate: \$355.00 per visit not to exceed 1 visit per day. This new rate is good for two years.

What happens next for claims already submitted

- For service dates September 2, 2012, or later
- Submitted for payment on or before the date of this notice

Amount billed	Your responsibility	DMAP responsibility
Less than \$355	Submit adjustment for new rate.	Manual reconciliation of leverage accounts
Greater than or equal to \$355	None	DMAP will automatically adjust these claims and manually reconcile leverage accounts.

What you need to do for claims that are not yet submitted and future claims

For dates of service	Bill at rate	When can you do this?
7/1/2012 through 9/1/2012	\$303 or above	Anytime
9/2/2012 and forward	\$355	Anytime
