In Clackamas, Multnomah and Washington counties, Health Share Coordinated Care Organization (CCO) currently incorporates four different plans:

- Care Oregon (transitioning from E390, E395, and E400 to E485, E490 and E495)
- Providence (transitioning from E415, E420, and E425 to E485, E490 and E495)
- Kaiser (transitioning from E405 and E410 to E485 and E490)
- Tuality (transitioning from E430 to E495)

Effective August 1, 2013, these four Health Share plans will combine a single CCO called Health Share of Oregon.

- All clients currently enrolled in one of the four plans listed above will be rolled-over into the new CCO.
- The level of benefits a client receives will not change.
- Clients will receive notification of this change directly from Health Share of Oregon, however no Coverage Letter (via MMIS) will be sent to clients since this does not change their benefits in any way.

DMAP will process this change using the Stop Reason RO – Roll-over code.
