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### **Public Health Advisory Board to meet Wednesday, Aug. 10**

**WHAT:** The Oregon Public Health Advisory Board will hold a special meeting to formulate recommendations for each of the HB3650 Health Services Transformation Workgroups.

**AGENDA:** Overview of work group process, charge and objectives; framing of public health issues, craft recommendations; discussion of Coordinated Care Organization criteria; Medicare/Medicaid integration care and services; outcomes metrics; global budget methodology.

It serves as an advisory board to the Oregon Health Authority on policy matters related to the operation of the authority, provides a review of statewide public health issues, and participates in public health policy development.
