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Oregon Health Policy Board to hold monthly meeting September 11 in Portland

What: The Oregon Health Policy Board will hold its monthly meeting on September 11 in Portland. The board will hear updates on Coordinated Care Organization implementation and the Metrics and Scoring Committee.
