Oregon Health Policy Board to hold monthly meeting August 6 in Portland

What: The Oregon Health Policy Board will hold its monthly meeting on August 6 in Portland. The board will hear a summary of the 2013 Legislative session and will review the second health system transformation quarterly report. The report will be released at the meeting. The board will also begin its work addressing the Governor's letter asking the Board to make recommendations on coordinated care model alignment and on strategies regarding rate review, cost shifting, decreasing premiums and increasing transparency and accountability. Public testimony will be heard during the meeting, beginning at 3:45 p.m.
