

On Jan. 10, 2023, Governor Tina Kotek declared a state of emergency due to unsheltered homelessness in the emergency areas (<u>EO 23-02</u>). Through HB 5019, the Legislature allocated approximately \$130 million (\$126.5M) to achieve the Governor's stated goals in the emergency areas by Jan. 10, 2024:
