

Affordable Rental Housing set as a priority in Statewide Housing Plan July '19-24








Goal: OHCS will triple the existing pipeline of affordable rental housing up to 25,000 homes.

Work to close the affordable rental housing gap and reduce housing cost burden for low-income Oregonians.

Annual Number of Funded Units

- Funding 3x more housing developments per year than in 2019
- OHCS has increased existing pipeline of affordable rental housing to over 25,000 homes.
- Need for housing continues to outpace growth
- Current number of funded units in 2023 is 2,453



- 15 homes


