Overall Progress Narrative:

Due to the complexity of standing up multiple programs simultaneously, OHCS is strategically **timing when programs are launched based on survivor needs and partner readiness.** The OHCS team continues to fill gaps in capacity and has onboarded a Chief Compliance Officer and multiple program staff. In addition to internal support, OHCS is finalizing the Program Management contract with the chosen vendor to continue to build capacity, especially for program launch. The HUD appointed technical assistance provider, Capital Access, completed all deliverables under their contract.

The bulk of OHCS' work right now is focused on standing up the system of record that will be used for the life of the grant. OHCS signed a contract for a system of record with Neighborly Software and we've begun work to configure and implement the system, focusing on PIER and HARP. PIER is fully configured and OHCS will begin testing of the system soon. The HARP application is mostly built and we have begun work on configuring administrative processes in the system.
