## Overall Progress Narrative:

In Q3 2024, staff focused on program implementation for PIER and HARP programs, continued development of the IHA program to prepare for implementation, worked with county partners to expand HOP program activities (resulting in the proposed restructure into Affordable Housing Development), and prepared the first Substantial Action Plan Amendment (SAPA).

SAPA highlights include the redesign of the Homeownership Opportunities Program that expands eligible activities and splits the original program into Down Payment Assistance and Affordable Housing Development; a new overarching program - Housing Support Services (HSS) - will consolidate Intermediate Housing Assistance, Down Payment Assistance and Housing Counseling under one umbrella in order to streamline the intake, application and referral process for impacted households; updates to Down Payment Assistance award structures; updated program pathways and award caps under the Homeowner Assistance and Reconstruction Program (HARP); and reallocation of HARP funds to support activities under AHD, PIER and HSS.

In Q3 2024, recovery programs continued to progress. Major milestone in Q3 include:

- Began awarding funds to PIER projects
- Pivoted to homeowner-managed process for construction for HARP to expedite delivery of funds
- Completed drafts policies for both Affordable Housing Development (AHD) program and Housing Support Services (HSS)
- Drafted a substantial action plan amendment, which was posted for public comment in October.

## OPERATIONS AND COMPLIANCE

The Compliance Team worked on the following during Q3 2024:

- Conducted an internal review of environmental clearance documentation for DCM, HARP Outreach and Intake subrecipients.
- Completed eight Capacity and Risk Assessments for potential PIER and IHA subrecipients. Capacity and Risk Assessment resulted in finding alternate subrecipients for two PIER projects.
- Conducted a mock review of one subrecipient for tecniaassistance. The mock review assisted the subrecipient and OHCS in identifying improvements to the following processes: budget, invoice, record keeping, and financial documentation meeting 2 CFR 200 requirements for internal control environment.
- Conducted a project review for a potential PIER project to determine whether, with the current facts and documentation, the project met national objectives.
- Completed a DRR file review for all HARP Outreach and Intake subrecipients.

## PROCUREMENT

The Procurement Team worked on the following during Q3 2024:

- PIER Program Subrecipient Agreement Templates are approved and ready for Subrecipient Information from Contract Admin to execute Agreements- approximately 15 Agreements
- IHA Master Subrecipient Agreements are approved and waiting for final changes to Scope of Work and Budgets- Total 4 Agreements
- Architectural and Engineering RFP- posted to Oregon Buys and closed October 8th
- General Contracts RFP- on hold
- Manufactured Homes RFP- on hold
- Executed several amendments

In addition to undertaking program and policy development for CDBG-DR funds, DRR staff continues to program \$150 million in state funding to support the recovery of wildfire-impacted households and communities. Results from that funding include:

- Rent assistance, purchase and repair grants and flexible assistance provided to 1,146 wildfire-impacted individuals through the Wildfire Recovery and Resilience Account (WRRA) \$35.3 million allocation. WRRA funding also helped 867 individuals achieve permanent housing.
- The development of over 200 permanent homes for wildfire survivors (another 569 affordable housing units with a wildfire preference and funded with tax credits and other state funding will be made available).
- Funding for the redevelopment and preservation of three destroyed affordable manufactured dwelling parks in Jackson and Lane Counties
- Largely thanks to the WRRA program, when FEMA closed their Direct Housing Mission in spring 2023, 200 survivors had moved to temporary or permanent housing and no survivor households were forced out of FEMA shelters.
- Direct county allocations totaling \$19 million to fund community-driven projects, home replacement grants and land acquisition.

OHCS is currently working on 8 state projects that include preserved manufactured home parks, stick built town homes, single family lots, and a tiny home village. OHCS has a total of over 200 units that are currently being developed for wildfire survivors.

**Narrative:** As outlined in the first Substantial Action Plan Amendment, OHCS has proposed a redesign of the Homeownership Opportunities Program. HOP, originally designed with two pathways ? Affordable Housing Development and Down Payment Assistance ? will now be redesigned into two separate programs. Affordable Housing Development (AHD) will be redesigned as a stand-alone program. It will be funded by redistributing a portion of the HOP allocation. An additional \$30M will be reallocated from Homeowner Assistance and Reconstruction Program (HARP) to support County efforts in the development of affordable housing. A new program, Housing Support Services (HSS), will be inclusive of three pathways, to include Down Payment Assistance (DPA), Intermediate Housing Assistance (IHA), and Housing Counseling. This program will combine funding allocations for IHA, the remainder of HOP funding, and \$5.5M from HARP will be reallocated to this program.

During Q3, OHCS continued to meet with impacted counties and county representatives who will administer AHD funds once the SAPA is complete to answer questions and provide technical assistance as they prepare for the launch of the program. In addition, OHCS prepared draft AHD policy for review. Launch is expected in early 2025.

The state provides a weekly touchpoint with intake subrecipients to provide training, technical assistance, and identify solutions that will convert more households into completed applications.

Draws for intake and outreach subrecipients have sped up in Q3 2024, but there continues to be a lag in receiving invoices and getting these through to payment for a variety of reasons. The state has provided technical assistance to partners to help with completing invoices and will be implementing process improvements in Q4 to better support partners with invoicing.

Other accomplishments in Q3 2024 include:

- Substantial Action Plan Amendment drafted that impacts several elements of HARP, including increasing award caps and adding a reimbursement pathway.
- Pivot to homeowner-managed construction to expedite process, with applications seeking construction expected to be able to move forward in Q4 2024.
- The 7 local subrecipient intake centers have worked within their communities to support both questionnaire and application submission through in-person and virtual support.




**Narrative:** As outlined in the SAPA, \$3.5M is proposed to be reallocated from HARP to the Planning, Infrastructure and Economic Revitalization (PIER) program to cover State activity delivery, to ensure that the previous allocation could be fully provided to the counties.



- OHCS continues to support 17 projects recommended by Selection Committees (7 Lane, 4 Jackson, 2 Lincoln, 2 Klamath, 2 Douglas). Four projects have been approved by OHCS (3 Jackson, 1 Douglas) with subrecipient agreements pending. Environmental review for the approved projects has started.
- Risk and Capacity Assessments have been initiated for all 17 project lead organizations. 6 organizations are identified as low risk, 9 are identified as medium risk, and 2 assessments are pending. OHCS has identified subrecipients for the medium risk organizations and intends to have 12 subrecipients for the 17 projects.
- The Jackson County Selection Committee has transitioned into an 11-member advisory committee that represents a more diverse balance of representation. The Advisory Committee will begin working in January 2025 to consider more projects with the remaining

allocation of Jackson's PIER funds.

- The Linn Board of County Commissioners signed a resolution to pool 100% of their allocated PIER funding with Marion County and operate as a joint Selection Committee with Marion County. The Marion/Linn Selection Committee is working on a plan to leverage PIER funding with other grants before selecting projects in February 2025. The Committee has also added a voting member from the City of Idanha. OHCS is providing technical assistance to the Committee and supports their planning efforts to make the best use of PIER funds.
- The Clackamas County PIER Selection Committee has been provided with a December 31, 2024, deadline to form per PIER policy. OHCS continues to contact the County bi-weekly by telephone and email, efforts are non-responsive.
- A PIER Subrecipient Toolkit has been activated online to serve as a one-stop resource to subrecipients or community members seeking information about PIER. The toolkit contains documents, forms, SOPs, training materials, and general information about the program. An interactive dashboard with program statistics, project information, public notices, and contract information is being developed.
- Two Program Analysts have been hired by OHCS to administer PIER agreements and provide technical assistance for communities with the PIER Program Manager.
