Have you recently sustained losses after a natural disaster such as a wildfire or flood? Do you have unpaid expenses insurance didn't cover?

Disaster Case Managers

Disaster case managers can help you assess what your needs are after you've experienced a disaster. Those needs may include food, clothing, shelter, first aid, emotional care, household items, or home repair not covered by insurance. Case managers will work with you to develop an Individualized Disaster Recovery Plan, which includes guidance and tools to help you. It can also connect you with a housing navigator to help you find temporary or long-term housing.

Housing Navigators

Housing navigators can help you speak to landlords, prepare rental applications, and get money to cover move-in costs such as rent and utility deposits. Translation services for multiple languages are also available.

Additional Resources for 2020 Wildfire Survivors

Renters who were affected by the 2020 wildfires can get help to pay for rent and utilities for up to 18 months, depending on their needs. Homeowners can get additional assistance with rebuilding or purchasing a new home. Oregonians can also get help with additional living expenses, even if they have insurance but it doesn't cover everything.

These resources are available to you, **regardless of income or immigration status**, but are limited and will be prioritized based on local need or other factors. Call **833-669-0554** (toll-free) to get connected to a disaster case manager or find local housing navigation resources.
