Basics: Who might be eligible for OHP or Marketplace Plans?

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OHP for Children in a family of 4 making up to ~\$80,000 / year REGARDLESS OF IMMIGRATION STATUS

OHP for Pregnant individuals in a family of 4 making up to ~\$58,000 / yr REGARDLESS OF IMMIGRATION STATUS

OHP for Adults in a family of 4 making up to ~\$36,000 / yr (including individuals up to 25 and 55+, regardless of immigration status)

OHP for Single Adults ~\$18,000 / yr (\$1507/month)

Marketplace plans with Financial Assistance available to citizens AND *Immigrants with any lawful presence*

OHP Health Coverage – more services for members

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- Physical / Behavioral / Dental / Vision health
- Expanded dental & vision (glasses) for youth and pregnant individuals
- Transportation to covered medical appointments
- Pregnant individuals and children have higher income limits
- Protected coverage 12 months after pregnancy ends (2 months for some)
- 90-day retroactive coverage (including deceased family)
- Program to pay for employer sponsored coverage <u>www.ReportTPL.org</u>
- Medicare Savings Programs to help pay for Medicare
- Emergency-only coverage now includes dialysis, cancer treatment, and mental health crisis

Special notes for assisting people with unstable housing and unaccompanied youth

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- No permanent living address needed
- Minors can apply on their own
