- Community Partners (OHA funded and not already funded)

We will have **staff dedicated** to support these events on the ground and **funding** to support these collaborative efforts.

Supporting events and partnerships

- OHA will support the matchmaking process
- Dedicated team to support event planning efforts
- Reimbursement and funding





Step 1: Fill out Interest Form

- Connect with your community partners to discuss collaboration for this work
 - **Promote** a vaccination effort
 - **Support** community members
 - Volunteer at an existing event
 - Host an event



Step 2: VOTE Team reaches out

- Vaccine Engagement Coordinator will reach out to discuss your event and how you'd like to get involved.
- Start the process on matchmaking
 - Finding a vaccinator if needed
 - Starting contract for payments
 - Getting vaccine allocation set up



Example of request or partnership

Organization intends to collaborate with a local pharmacy to serve a specific community group

- OHA will connect a pharmacy or vaccination site
- Local organization will conduct outreach and schedule times
- Transportation needs assessed and booked by community partner



Example of request or partnership

A church wants to vaccinate homebound individuals in their congregation and finds a CBO partner.

- Mobile vaccination unit is identified by OHA
- CBO will work with church on outreach
- Church and CP will schedule appointments
- Trusted members might travel with the mobile unit
- Language needs will be supported- translators can be paid under this grant



Example of request or partnership

A faith organization wants to host a large event in their parking lot with a resource fair

- Faith Organization will lead planning logistics
 - Create a community resource area—invite partners
 - Coordinate vaccine distribution with local public health
 - Schedule times
- Vaccinator/Health Partner will lead other logistics
 - Create flow for physical distancing
 - Bring vaccine, perform data entry and tracking



Example of requests or partnerships

A LGBTQ+ celebration with performances and health care providers in Drag.

- LGBTQ+ Organizations plan the event
- Outreach, performances, stage, audio needs
- Health System- Federally Qualified Health Center provides vaccinators.
- OHA funds LGBTQ Organizations, gets FQHC allocations if needed.

If selected, OHA will work with applicants to find solutions or other needed resources.

This could include:

- Financial support
- Coordinating vaccine doses
- Connecting event host(s) with vaccinators
- Connecting hosts with a testing team representative
- Supporting accessibility needs
- Communication with LPHAs for situational awareness
