\$40M

The Disaster Resilience Infrastructure Program will provide money for public infrastructure or projects related to:

- ✓ **NEW HOUSING** (Example: Waste-water treatment needed for new housing or parks for new neighborhoods)
- ✓ **MITIGATING THE LOSS OF LIFE OR PROPERTY FROM NATURAL HAZARDS** (Example: New or improved public safety communications equipment)

The program will be competitive and may be implemented in multiple rounds.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS:

- Tribal, state, county, and local governments, agencies, districts, and authorities
- Schools (K–12)
- Public housing authorities
- Other public or quasi-public entities
- Nonprofits with a public role specified in Oregon law (e.g., soil and water conservation districts)

Community Planning & Revitalization Program

\$8M

The Community Planning and Revitalization Program will pay for many different types of disaster recovery or preparedness planning, such as:

- ✓ **HOUSING DEVELOPMENT STRATEGIES**
- ✓ **ECONOMIC REVITALIZATION PLANS**
- ✓ **LAND USE STUDIES**
- ✓ **INFRASTRUCTURE PLANS OR PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING**
- ✓ **DISASTER RESILIENCE AND PREPAREDNESS POLICY AND PLANNING**

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS:

- Tribal, state, county, and local governments, agencies, and authorities
- Schools (K–12)
- Public housing authorities
- Other public or quasi-public entities, including councils of government and other regional organizations and economic development districts
- Long-term recovery groups and other community or housing development nonprofit organizations
