

# Oregon Manufactured Home Park Directory

## An Overview

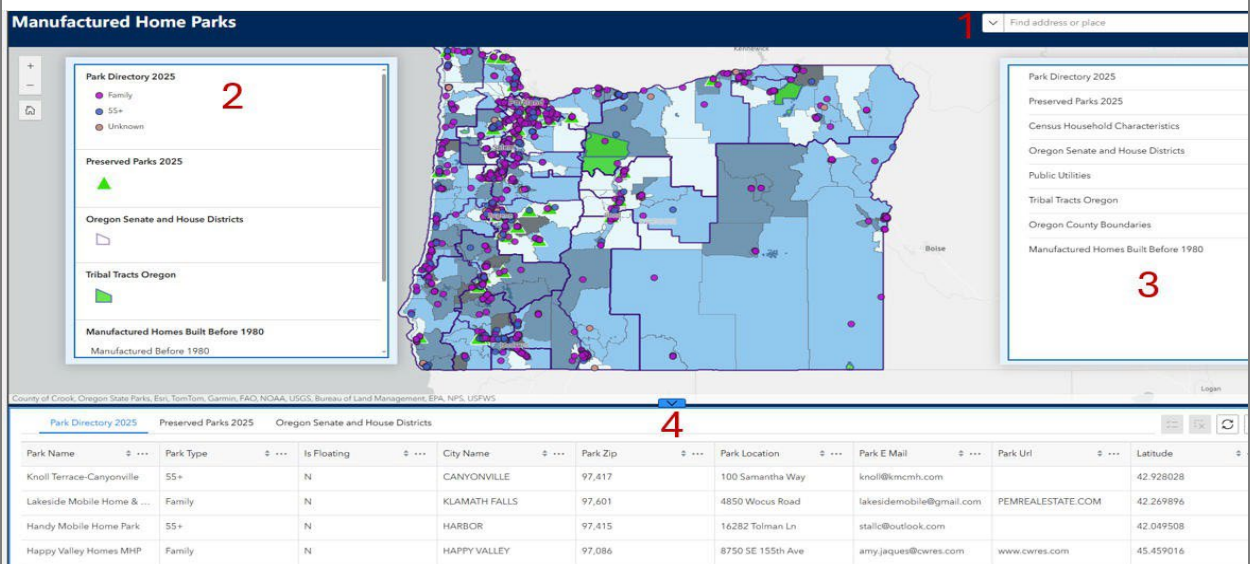


Figure 1: Map Interface (default extent and layers)

The [Oregon Manufactured Home Parks Directory Map](#) is a web application that shows the locations of all mobile and manufactured home parks reported to Oregon Housing and Community Services. Other layers display demographic and housing information from the American Community Survey (ACS) five-year estimates, various geographic boundaries, markers for OHCS-supported park preservation projects since 2006, and the service areas of numerous energy utility providers. The tools and icons marked on the map interface as shown in Figure 1 will help you to navigate the map and set your display preferences. Below are nine items that are marked on the map interface in Figure 1.

## Map Tools

- 1. Search Box:** Allows you to search for any address (or city, county, etc.) or park.
- 2. Legend:** This is the map legend.
- 3. Layer Box:** To turn a layer on or off, check or uncheck the "eye" icon.
- 4. Park List:** Use this list to view our directory of manufactured home parks in Oregon.

## Toggle and Explore Layers

When a layer's box is checked within the Layers List (item #3 in Figure 1), its data will be shown and can then be clicked on within the map. Clicking on any mapped area will bring up a pop-up window with all activated layers' details shown, as they apply to the point clicked. For example, clicking on a manufactured home park (blue circles) will result in a window displaying the information for that park, as well as the ACS data for the Census tract in which the park lies (plus whichever other layers apply to that spot and are turned on).

	<p><b>Layers</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Preserved Parks – Park locations are marked with green triangles.</li><li>2. Park Directory 2025 – Purple circles represent family parks; dark blue circles represent age 55+ park communities.</li><li>3. Tribal Land: Tribal land in Oregon.</li><li>4. Year Built (Census Tracts): Displays Census tracts in varying shades of blue according to the estimated number of manufactured homes in the tract constructed prior to 1980.</li><li>5. Publicly Owned Utilities – When activated, shows coverage areas for publicly owned utilities.</li><li>6. OR Senate and House Districts – When the corresponding box in the Layers List is checked, Oregon House of Representatives are drawn in blue.</li><li>7. Census Tract Data (ACS Estimates) – Pop-up box contains additional demographic and housing stock information.</li></ol>
