In addition to focusing on legislation and property rights, OPOA is pleased to present a series of [Park Manager Training Classes](#) that satisfy the requirements of Oregon Law. The course has been developed by OPOA Legal Counsel [Charles M. Greeff](#), who is recognized as being an attorney with striking knowledge and experience in Oregon landlord-tenant law relating to mobile home parks and manufactured housing communities.

Charles M. Greeff, General Counsel

Charles M. Greeff is an attorney practicing law in Lake Oswego. He has practiced since 1989 and has owned his own business since 1995. He specializes in residential and commercial landlord/tenant disputes; business litigation, eviction trials and appeals; and real property.

Manufactured dwelling and RV park owner rights and responsibilities, and fair housing compliance, have been a central focus of Greeff's practice since 1991. He is certified by the state as a trainer for manufactured dwelling park managers and owners. He has participated in the Oregon Residential Landlord Tenant Legislative Coalition since 1997 on behalf of park owners and landlords. Greeff has represented the Oregon Park Owners' Alliance since its inception in 1999. In 2006, Greeff received the Oregon Lodging Association's Industry Partner of the Year Award.

Oregon law requires that the on-site manager – or an off-site manager or owner – must attend a minimum of four hours training every two years.

The MHCO Annual Conference will be on October 23rd & 24th. It will be held in Eugene, Oregon at the Graduate Hotel on 66 E 6th Ave, Eugene, OR 97401. **Registration** will be available in late August/early September.

MHCO is a registered education provider with the Oregon Real Estate Agency.

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Center for Dialogue and Resolution (CDR) has been serving Lane County as a non-profit organization since 1982. For the past four decades, CDR has been building more peaceful communities in Lane County. CDR services include training and workshops for Restorative Justice in both Municipal and Circuit Courts, Separation/Divorce, co-parenting, communication skills, family and, Landlord Tenant mediation and a variety of communication-oriented disciplines. CDR conducts trainings throughout the year in a broad range of topics. Authorized by Oregon Housing and Community Services, CDR announces an expansion of services to now include Landlord Continuing Education training to management and owners of MHP statewide. Given sessions are on-site at CDR offices and designed to promote

engagement, sessions are limited to twenty participants.

CDR's Landlord Continued Education sessions are led by Matthew Johnson, Attorney at Law P.C. Practicing since 1996, Attorney Johnson was admitted to both the Oregon Bar and Oregon Federal District Court. He began his solo practice in Eugene specializing in Tenant/Landlord law and Housing and Employment discrimination. Mr. Johnson first became interested in Tenant/landlord law in the early 90's, as an undergraduate at the University of Oregon. During law school he worked at the Lane County Legal Aid office where he focused on Tenant/landlord issues. After graduation he opened his solo practice, relying largely on tenant/landlord referrals from Legal Aid for the first two years setting up his practice.

In 2002 Matthew took his talents to the Western Pacific's, Republic of Palau. The Palau Public Lands Authority hired Mr. Johnson to represent the Palau government for land tenure claims. He returned to the US and reestablished his current practice in 2005 and quickly developed a particular expertise in Tenant/landlord law as it applies in Manufactured Home facilities.
