Worker Permits

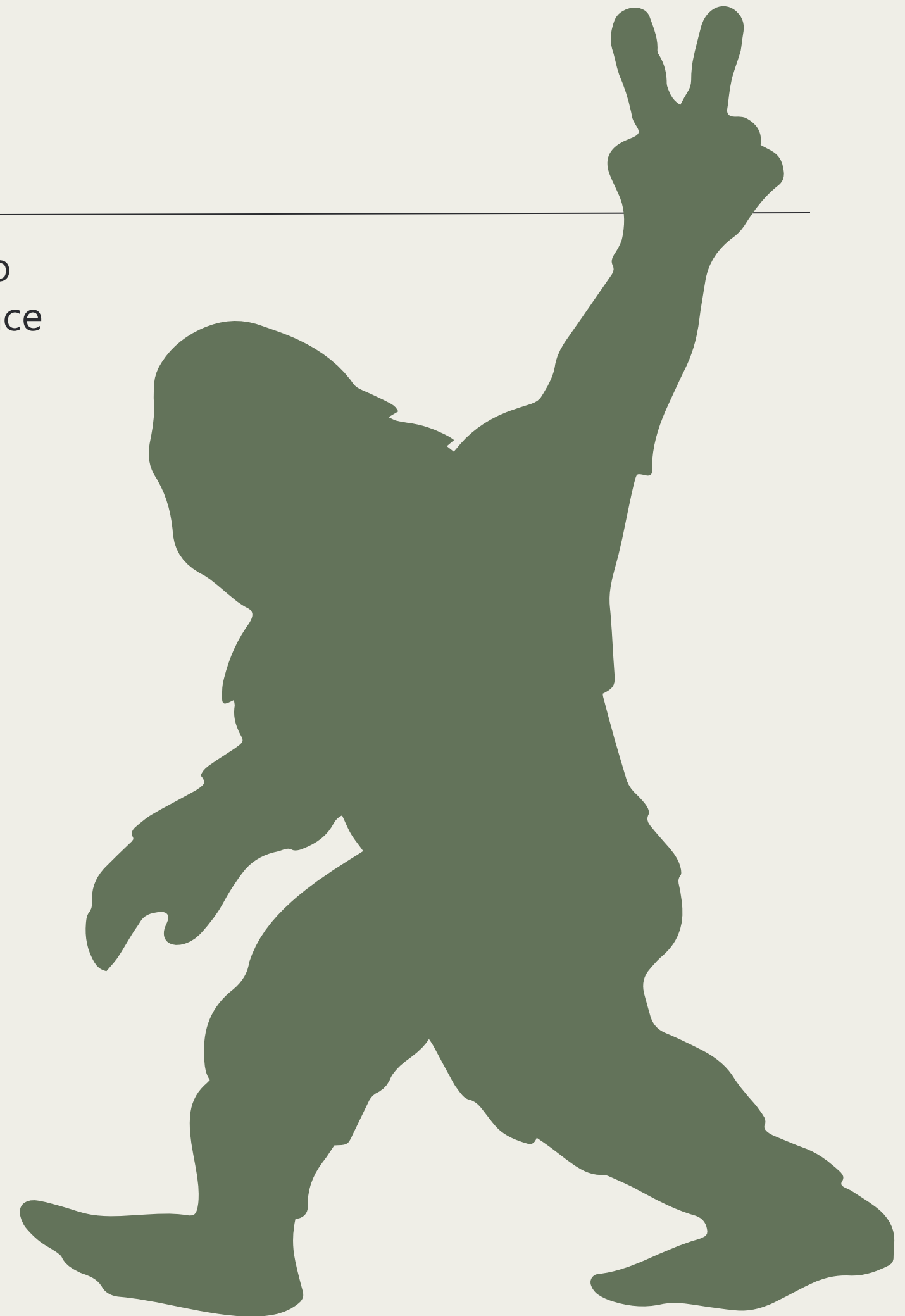

Go Live - March 18, 2024

FEATURES OF CAMP

Smart scaling for use on computers or smart devices

Native mobile app for OLCC staff, improving field efficiency

Online submission and payment for all license actions

- (No more outside payments required for marijuana license changes!)
- Cash & checks still accepted with appointment
- Combine payments for multiple actions

Single log-in and multi-user access

- View and manage license and permit applications without needing to switch accounts
- Users may authorize their representatives to view and manage licenses through their own accounts & dashboards

Security options

- Primary account holder may revoke multi-user access
- For license applications, individual history information submitted directly to OLCC without needing to pass through primary account-holder/applicant



FIRST TIME ACCESS FOR CURRENT USERS

Watch your **business mailing address** and **existing account email** for your PIN. If you have multiple accounts in the current licensing system, you will receive multiple PINs.

CAMP ACCESS CHECKLIST

- Visit the OLCC CAMP site and access the user portal.
- Click “Login/Register” and follow prompts to “Sign Up Now.”
- Sign up with email or use a Google, Microsoft, or Apple ID.
- Once registered, associate your license(s) using your PIN(s).

IMPORTANT: The email or third-party ID used to associate the license(s) should be controlled by a licensee. You may add additional authorized users after initial set-up.

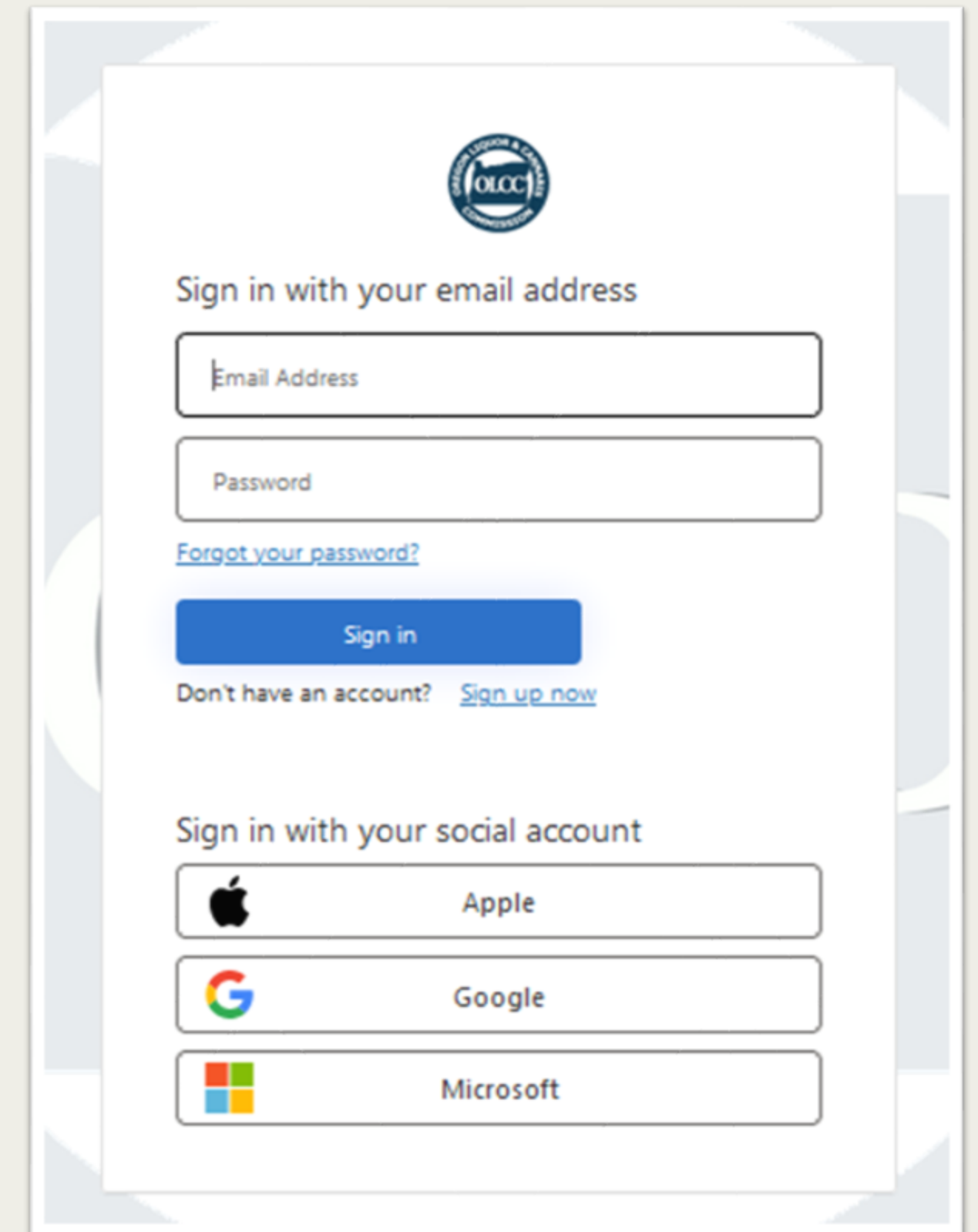
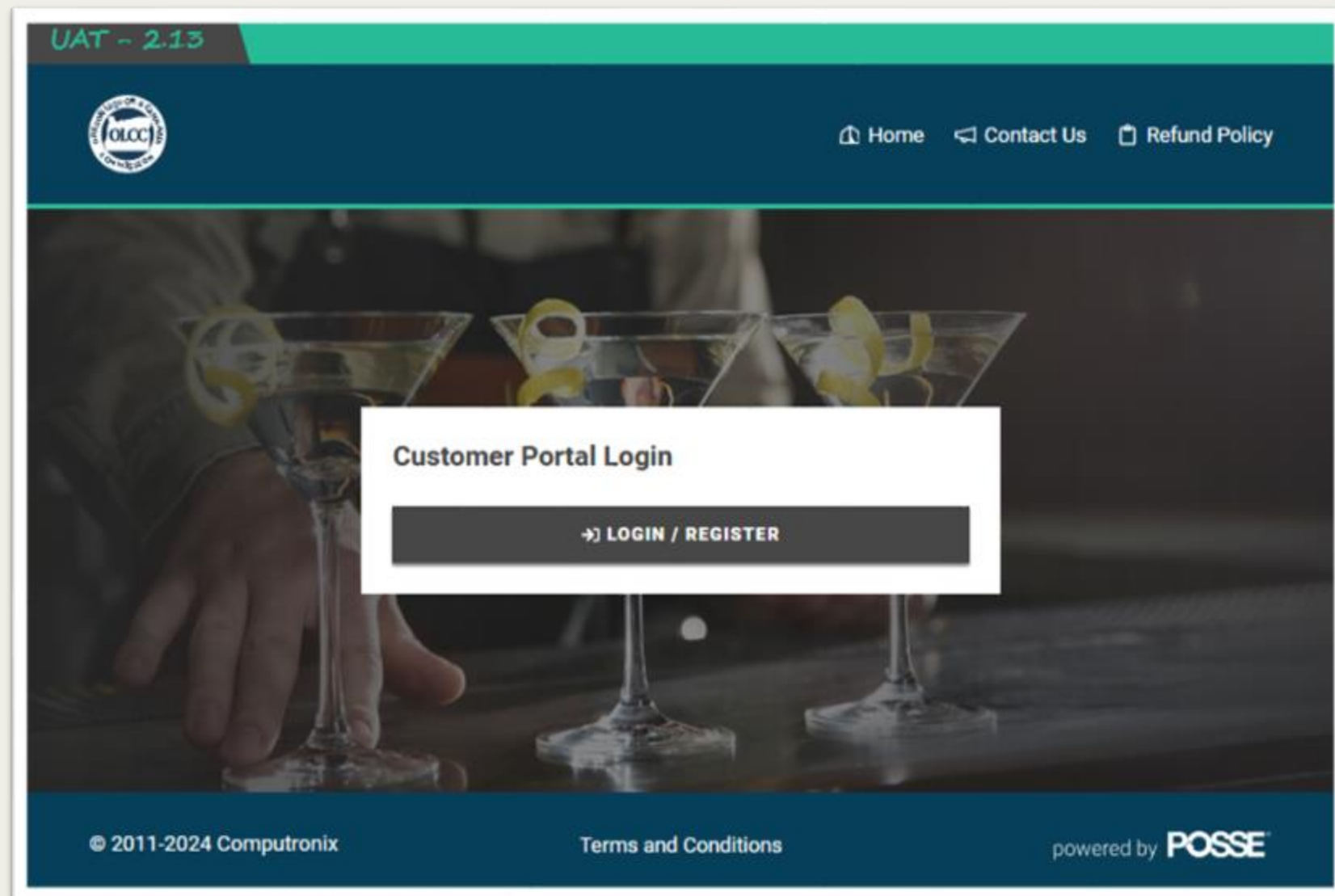

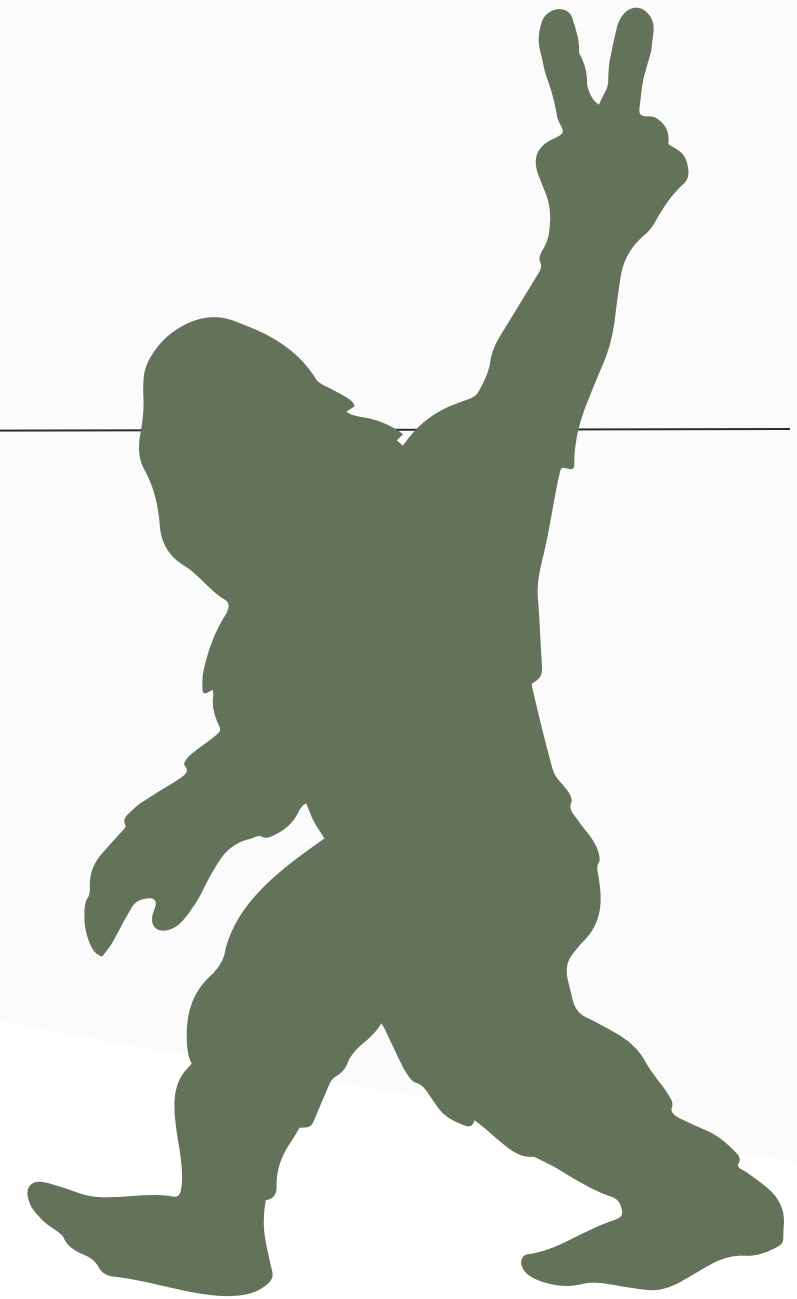
