A number of modifications to alcohol regulations were introduced during this session.

SB 871 EN <u>OLCC Priority</u> Chapter Number: Chapter 293 , 2025 Laws. Effective Date: 91st day following adjournment sine die.	INTRODUCED BY: At the request of Governor Kotek for OLCC The Bill made the following key changes: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Invoice Retention: Requires OLCC retail licensees to maintain invoices for all alcoholic beverage deliveries. The invoices must be kept for three years from the date of delivery and made available for inspection upon request by OLCC.• Definition of Alcoholic Beverages: SB 871 updates the definition of "alcoholic beverages" items to include liquid or solids containing one-half of one percent (.5%) or more alcohol by volume.• Reporting Requirement: Removes the requirement for licensees to submit a specified monthly report to the commission to OLCC detailing the quantity of alcoholic beverages received from direct-to-retail permit holders.
