If the OLCC approves the application, the redemption center at the new location will accept redeemable bottles and cans and pay the 10-cent refund per container. The current location will continue to operate until the new location is approved and operational. **If approved, the stores listed in Zone 1 will not accept returnable containers and the stores listed in Zone 2 will limit returns to 24 containers per person per day.**

The applicant proposes to be open seven days per week from 8 AM to 7 PM in summer and from 8 AM to 6 PM during the rest of the year, and will provide bag drop-off services from 6 AM to 10 PM. The center will accept up to 350 containers per person per day through self-service machines, 50 containers per person per day counted by center staff, and 15 bags per account per calendar quarter. At least 55 parking spaces will be made available.

If approved, the redemption center is anticipated to open in Spring 2021. We are posting this public notice as part of the application process.
