

## Annual Beverage Container Sales/Returns Report for CY 2020

For the purpose of this report, “beverages” refers to ones that have a 10-cent Oregon refund value. Beverages that must be reported annually to OLCC include, but are not limited to:

- Beer and other malt beverages, water, carbonated beverages, kombucha, and hard seltzer in metal, glass, and plastic bottles and cans in sizes 3 liters or less
- Most other beverages in metal, glass, and plastic bottles and cans in sizes from 4 ounces up to and including 1.5 liters. Examples include but are not limited to the following ready-to-drink beverages:
  - Tea and Coffee
  - Fruit and Vegetable Juice
  - Energy and Sports Drinks
  - Hard Cider at 8.5% ABV or less
  - Cocktail Mixers
  - Marijuana and Hemp beverages
  - Oral Electrolyte Replacement Beverages
  - Other non-carbonated beverages

**Beverages that do not have a 10-cent Oregon refund value and must not be reported include:**

- Distilled Spirits
- Wine (including Cider over 8.5% ABV)
- Milk (both dairy and plant-based), but only if milk is listed as the first ingredient
- Infant Formula
- Liquid Meal Replacements
