TEMPORARY ACTION

• **Delivery of Alcoholic Beverages Direct to Consumer** Action The Alcohol Delivery Rules package is a response to House Bill 3308, which passed in the 2023 legislative session. That bill was the result of continuing changes to Oregon's alcohol regulatory environment, and a desire by various stakeholders to develop additional regulations around the safe delivery of alcoholic beverages to final consumers. OLCC staff are presenting this rules package to implement this legislation by requiring permitting of third-party delivery companies and approved training for alcohol delivery drivers, in addition to setting requirements to obtain a delivery permit from the agency and penalties for compliance failures. Because House Bill 3308 becomes effective on January 1, 2024, OLCC staff present this rules package as a temporary action, with permanent rules anticipated no later than June 1, 2024.

FINAL ACTION

• **2023** Alcohol Housekeeping and Technical Updates Action This rulemaking package is in response to HB 2013, SB 1052, and the need for housekeeping updates to some current rules.
