2025 Alcohol Housekeeping & Technical Rules Package

Action

Senate Bill 871 has several provisions that require agency rulemaking to implement.

2025 Bottle Bill Rules Package

Action

2025 Senate Bill 992 directs OLCC to develop rules for and to approve qualifying applications to provide alternative access redemption centers that provide bottle redemption access to individuals who return bottles on a daily or near-daily basis. These redemption centers may not refuse to pay the refund value of less than 350 beverage containers by any one person during one day and provide hand counting of up to 50 beverage containers for one person in one day. Senate Bill 992 also requires the OLCC to establish alternative access and low impact convenience zones and adjusts hours of operation of bottle redemption centers in various zones.

2025 Hemp Product Registry Rules Package

Action

House Bill 4121 requires the OLCC to adopt a hemp product registry. OLCC staff propose adopting new rules in Division 26 and renaming Division 26 to accommodate the product registry.

2025 Marijuana Legislative & Technical Package

Action

The Legislature passed several bills that require agency rulemaking to implement. The agency must also undertake rulemaking to respond to changes within the industry and consider whether technical adjustments are necessary. OLCC staff propose amending rules in Division 25 to implement legislative and technical changes.

2025 Division 4 CAMP and Communication Changes

Action

OLCC staff identified areas where technical updates and clarifications were needed for both alcohol and marijuana regulations. OLCC staff propose amending OAR 845-004-0065 as part of the technical updates for marijuana and alcohol licensing programs.
