Commission approves Marijuana Licensee Stipulated Settlements

PORTLAND, OR. – At its regular monthly meeting on February 18, 2021, the Oregon Liquor Control Commission ratified the following violation fines and suspensions based on stipulated settlements (*detailed information on specific cases can be found [here](#) on the [OLCC website](#)*):

NIGHTWOOD HORTICULTURE will pay a \$3,465 fine and serve a 23-day recreational marijuana producer license suspension OR serve a 44-day license suspension for four violations.

Licensee is: Nightwood Horticulture Limited; Allen Clark, President, Secretary, Director, Stockholder.

THE DISPENSARY ON 52ND in Portland will pay a \$6,435 fine and serve a two-day recreational marijuana retailer license suspension OR serve a 41-day license suspension for two violations.

Licensees are: Dicot Derby Farms, LLC; Alan Kamben, Member.

OREGON'S GREEN RUSH will pay a \$15,345 fine OR serve a 93-day recreational marijuana retailer license suspension for five violations.

Licensees are: Simplee Green, LLC; Janice Grossman, Member.

EUGENIUS will surrender its producer license at the earlier of the date of transfer of ownership of the business or March 31, 2021 for six violations.

Licensee is: Eugenius, LLC; Trey Willison, Managing Member.

Additionally, the Commission placed a restriction on the renewal application for the recreational marijuana retail license of Creative Crops Rec operating in Bend.
