OLCC Suspends Off-Premises Sales License of Stop N Go Mini Mart

Agency Proposes to Cancel License

PORTLAND, Ore. – On March 21, 2025, the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission (OLCC) issued an Order of Emergency License Suspension to the off-premises sales licensee of Stop N Go Mini Mart in Portland. The licensee must not exercise any license privileges at the licensed premises as continued operation represents a serious danger to public health and safety.

Five violations occurred in 2024 and 2025 involving the permitting of unlawful activities. Based on the number of violations, and the aggravating factors, the agency proposes license cancelation. The Commission specifically alleges that the number of violations indicate a disregard for the law or failure to control the premises.

Notice has been posted at the licensed premises. Licensee has the right to a hearing to dispute the charges and/or the proposed license cancellation by April 21.
