Further, I understand that false swearing under ORS 162.075 is a Class A misdemeanor punishable by a fine of up to \$5,000 and/or six months imprisonment.

INSTRUCTIONS TO LICENSEES, PERMITTEES AND CLERKS

1. If a person appears under age 26, before selling or serving alcoholic liquor to that person, you must require the person to produce: an unexpired and unaltered U.S. state or District of Columbia driver license; an unexpired and unaltered identification card issued by a U.S. state, District of Columbia, or a territory of the US, with photo, name, date of birth, and physical description; an unexpired and unaltered ID card issued by a federally recognized Indian tribe with photo, name, physical description, and date of birth; an unexpired and unaltered passport or passport card; an unexpired and unaltered U.S. military ID card; an unexpired and unaltered NEXUS or SENTRI card.
2. If the person does not have one of the stand-alone identifications described above, the person must complete a Statement of Age card.
3. To complete the Statement of Age card, the person must furnish at least one descriptive piece of ID which shows the name, address, date of birth, physical description or photo, signature, **AND** a second piece of ID to verify their identity. Each piece of ID must be examined carefully to determine that:
 - a) it is correctly transcribed to the Statement of Age form;
 - b) it has not been altered, erased or changed in any manner;
 - c) the physical description and signature match that of the person whose age is questioned; **AND**
 - d) the person is 21 years of age or older.

MAIL ORDER OR SIMILAR UNOFFICIAL IDENTIFICATION CARDS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.

4. After completion of steps 1 through 3, if you are not satisfied that the person is 21 years of age or over, **DO NOT SELL OR SERVE ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR TO THAT PERSON.**
