

Oregon Liquor & Cannabis Commission Rules Advisory Committee Meeting

2026 Limited Lifting of Marijuana License Moratorium

Agenda

The 2024 Oregon Legislature passed House Bill 4121 which established per capita limits on marijuana licenses by license type. OLCC subsequently amended several rules to incorporate these limits, as well as the requirement that OLCC lift the moratorium for specific license types when the number of active licenses for that type fall below the specified numbers of Oregon residents.

At this time staff estimate it is likely the volume of wholesale licenses, and possibly other license types, have fallen below the stated population thresholds so that the moratorium may be lifted for those types. Staff believe additional rulemaking is necessary to establish processes, standards, and timelines for receiving and processing new applications for any license type that falls below the prescribed population ratios.
