***Producer* Application Submission Deadlines**

(1) All **license** *producer* applications submitted on or before *June 15, 2018* **January 1, 2022** through the Commission's online licensing system with the non-refundable application fee will be held until the application is assigned to a Commission staff member.

(2) Producer applications will only be processed after the application is assigned to a Commission staff member.

(23) Producer a Applications **for producer, processor, wholesaler, and retailer licenses** submitted after *June 15, 2018* **January 1, 2022** will be inactivated.

Prohibited Changes to License Applications

(1) The Commission will not allow changes of ownership of an application after submission of an application for licensure.

(2) For purposes of this rule, "change of ownership" is defined as:

(a) Adding or replacing an applicant who will be a licensee of record; or

(b) A business changing its ownership structure such that natural persons who did not previously hold a direct or indirect interest in the business will collectively hold a direct or indirect interest of 51 percent or greater.

(3) Until *January 2, 2022* **March 31, 2024**, an applicant that submitted an application for a *production producer* license under ORS 475C.065, **a processor license under ORS 475C.085, a wholesaler license under ORS 475C.093, or a retailer license under ORS 475C.097** on or before *June 15, 2018* **January 1, 2022** may not change the location of the proposed licensed premises for which the application was submitted.

(4) The Commission will not allow an applicant to change the license type of the application after submission of an application for licensure.
