Limited Lifting of Marijuana License Moratorium (Wholesale Licenses)

Summary: The 2024 Oregon Legislature passed House Bill 4121 which established per capita limits on marijuana licenses by license type. At this time OLCC estimate that the volume of wholesale licenses has fallen below the stated population thresholds so that a moratorium may be lifted and approximately 30 wholesale licenses may be issued.

Concepts/Feedback Topics

- **Submission of preliminary interest in applying for a wholesale license.**
Required disclosure of full business structure and verified suitable location
- **Public Notice.** Timelines, deadlines, methods of submission
- **Prohibiting duplicate submissions.** Applicants will need to be unique and not appear on other submissions of interest
- **Random selection if volume exceeds the number of available licenses.** All qualifying submissions would be permitted to apply if volume does not exceed available licenses
- **Prohibiting changes in applicants and location prior to approval.** Once licensed, approved location/business structure changes (including ownership changes) would be permitted
