NOT Included Beverages

There is never a refund value on beverages in cartons, foil pouches, drink boxes, or metal container that requires a tool to be opened. The following beverages are NOT INCLUDED even if they are in glass, metal, or plastic bottles or cans:

- Distilled spirits
- Wine
 - Mead
 - Hard cider over 8.5% ABV
- Milk (dairy and plant-based)
 - Flavored milk
 - Buttermilk
 - Lactose-free milk
 - Cultured milk
 - Kefir (unless it contains fruit, grains, etc.)
- Infant formula
- Beverages marketed specifically as meal-replacement drinks
- Concentrated beverages
 - Lemon/lime juice
 - Frozen juice concentrate
 - Concentrated coffee/tea
 - Concentrated cocktail mixers
- Syrups/ flavorings
 - Triple sec
 - Grenadine
 - Bitters
 - Shrubs
- Coffee creamers
- Non-beverage foods:
 - Condiments (like soy sauce)
 - Olive oil
 - Vinegar (except for beverages that are specifically called drinking vinegar)



Manufacturers have until January 1, 2019 to include OR 10¢ on containers for the beverages that were added on January 1, 2018. Even though these beverages may not have the refund value on the container, they have a 10-cent Oregon refund value and can be redeemed.
